This course will cover Lesson 1 through Lesson 6 of Genki I third edition. Classes will be conducted as much as possible in Japanese. Regular attendance and participation are expected. The first level of Japanese is for the beginners who have no formal training in the language.

Section 2

[Course Objectives]

This course aims to develop basic communication skills (mainly speaking and listening skills) through a wide variety of activities based on practical situations which a student of Japanese could expect to encounter. The students will learn hiragana, katakana, 40 kanji characters, approximately 300 vocabulary words (basic nouns, verbs, adjectives, and expressions), pronunciation and basic grammar in "long forms" (formal/polite forms). The students will also practice to function in Japanese in everyday situations such as making requests, describing things/people, asking for permissions, stating reasons, etc. This course will cover Lesson 1 through Lesson 6 of *Genki* 1.


