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【Course Outline / Description】

The fourth level of Kanji and Readings in Japanese. This course is designed for those who are enrolled in Japanese 4 or an upper level. Students must hold an understanding of basic Japanese grammar. 160 more kanji will be introduced during the semester. Students will be using basic grammar tools to focus on reading and writing on various topics. This course will cover Lesson 22 through Lesson 31 of Kanji Look and Learn textbook and workbook.

Section 2

【Course Objectives/Goals/Learning Outcomes】

Students will learn 160 kanji and kanji words in Lesson 22 through Lesson 31 of Kanji Look and Learn textbook and workbook.

Students will expand one's vocabulary and improve reading comprehension by reading various reading materials, including a biography, an advertisement and a questionnaire.

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【Course Outline / Description】

The fourth level of Kanji and Readings in Japanese. Students must have an understanding of basic Japanese grammar. 176 kanji will be introduced during the semester. Students will be using basic grammar for reading and writing on various topics, while expanding their kanji and vocabulary knowledge. We will read materials, including biographies, advertisements and questionnaires. Students also write three short essays on certain topics. This course will cover Lesson 22 through Lesson 32 of the Kanji Look and Learn textbook and workbook.

We will use Blackboard and Zoom as communication tools. The instruction and the learning materials for each class will be posted in Blackboard. Students are requested to check the course schedule and Blackboard on each class day. Students have a self-study session on Tuesdays and a Zoom session on Thursdays. (There are some exceptions.)
