### 【Course Outline / Description】

The first level of Japanese for beginners who have no formal training in the language. This course aims mainly at the development of speaking and listening skills. Approximately 300 vocabulary words will be introduced. At the end of the course, successful students should be able to function in Japanese in everyday situations such as making requests, stating reasons, describing things, etc. This course will cover Lesson 1 through Lesson 6 of *Genki I Third edition*.

1. Learn vocabulary (approx. 300 basic nouns, verbs, adjectives, and expressions).
2. Learn the pronunciation of the Japanese language.
