#### Section 1

### [Course Outline / Description]

The second level of Elementary Spoken Japanese. New students must pass a placement test to enroll. This course will cover Lesson 6 through Lesson 12 of Genki I second edition. Students will continue to develop their Japanese from the basic skills of communication in Japanese. The course focuses on extensive speaking and listening practice, introducing vocabulary, grammar, and expressions, including "te-forms", "short forms", comparison, stating desire, etc. Approximately 300 words will be introduced.
