[Learning Assessments/Grading Rubric]

Participation: 30% Final Project: 60%

The level of technical skill and quality of work: 10%

The level of technical skill is influencing student's grade, but also the development of the skill during the semester and the effort to work hard, which will definitely show up in student's works. Also students who are not used to draw are welcome to the class, no prior experience in drawing is required.

Instead of Final exam, students are asked to finish a manga project till the end of the semester, including an exhibition.

Section 5

[Additional Information]

No prior experience in drawing is required, but every student has to work hard, even outside of the class, to finish the project. Everyone who is interested in drawing manga is welcome to the class. The class is also targeting those, who would like to work in a project, which is producing manga booklet.

A material fee of \$10,000 per semester, payable in advance, will be charged(non-refundable).

The material fees are NOT refundable even though you drop the course.
