### [Course Outline / Description]

The third level of elementary Japanese. New students must pass a placement test in order to enroll. Students will continue to develop their Japanese from the foundational skills established in the elementary level courses. The course focuses on extensive speaking and listening practice, introducing vocabulary, grammar and expressions. At the end of the course, students are expected to be able to adequately handle everyday conversation in Japanese, including saying what you can or cannot do, explaining about people or things in detail, apologizing, talking about hopes and wishes, and conveying hearsay. Also, approximately 90 kanji will be introduced. This course will cover Lesson 13 through Lesson 18 of *Genki II* second edition. We will meet three times a week (90 minutes each session).

#### Section 2

[Course Objectives/Goals/Learning Outcomes]

At the end of the course, students are expected to be able to adequately handle everyday conversation in Japanese, including saying what you can or cannot do, explaining about people or things in detail, apologizing, talking about hopes and wishes, and conveying hearsay. Also, approximately 90 kanji will be introduced. This course will cover Lesson 13 through Lesson 18 of *Genki II* second edition.
