#### 【Course Outline / Description】

This course aims at providing beginning level students with practical skills of Japanese language essential to their successful communication in various settings. This course aims mainly to develop speaking and listening skills, but part of the class time is spent on practicing kanji characters. In addition to the basic 210 kanji covered in JPN level 1-3, approximately 100 kanji that appear in the dialogue of Lesson 18 through Lesson 23 of Genki book will be introduced.

At the end of the course, successful students should be able to gain knowledge of basic grammar and of idiomatic expressions commonly encountered in daily Japanese life. They are also expected to be able to demonstrate basic writing skills and ability to express ideas in coherent paragraphs. They will be able to read/write email texts, letters, short essays, etc.

A variety of classroom activities are designed to help students acquire these grammar points as well as useful vocabulary words related to the topic provided in the textbook, and to improve all four skills: listening, speaking, writing and reading, with the emphasis on the first two in this class.
