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【Course Outline / Description】

The first level of Japanese for beginners who have no formal training in the language. This course will be conducted using the Zoom online meeting application.

Section 2

【Course Objectives/Goals/Learning Outcomes】

This course aims mainly at the development of speaking and listening skills, but also writing in *hiragana*, *katakana* and basic *kanji*. Approximately 300 vocabulary words will be introduced. At the end of the course, successful students will be able to function in Japanese in everyday situations such as making requests, stating reasons, describing things, etc. Also, approximately 40 *kanji* will be introduced. This course will cover Lessons 1 through 6 of *Genki I* third edition.
