[Course Outline / Description]

This course aims mainly to develop four skills – speaking, listening, reading, and writing, but the primary emphasis will be on speaking. A part of the class time is spent on practicing reading kanji characters. At the end of the course, successful students will have developed the skills of using various expressions needed in various situations commonly encountered in Japanese daily life, including honorific and humble expressions. In addition to the basic 224 kanji covered in JPN level 1-3, approximately 90 kanji that appear in the dialogue of Lesson 18 through Lesson 23 of Genki book will be introduced.

[Course Objectives/Goals/Learning Outcomes]

This course aims at providing beginning level students with practical skills of Japanese language essential to their successful communication in various settings. The followings are some main grammar points learned in this course:

- Transitive and Intransitive verbs
- Honorific, Extra-Modest, and Humble Expressions
- Passive form
- Causative form
- Causative-Passive form
- Conditional expression, such as ~ば、~と
- ~ながら、~間に etc...

With these grammar points, students who successfully complete this course will be able to the followings:

- Describe the states of things
- Talk about things that we are glad that we did
- Talk about bad experience and regrets
- Return merchandise
- Talk about getting people to do things
- Ask for and give advice
- Express opinions
- Complain about doing something undesirable
- Hold conversations in situations commonly encountered as well as in formal settings with honorific and humble expressions, etc.
