JAPANESE 2

[Course Description]

Prerequisite: Japanese 1 (or its equivalent)

This course is the second level in elementary Japanese. New students must pass a placement test to enroll. Students will continue to develop their basic communication skills in Japanese. The course focuses on extensive speaking and listening practice, introducing vocabulary, grammar, and expressions, such as "te-forms," "short forms," comparison, and stating desire. This course also focuses on developing students' writing skills for communicative purposes. Approximately 300 words and 70 kanji will be introduced. This course will cover Lesson 6 through Lesson 12 of Genki I Third edition, which is equivalent to JLPT* N5 or CEFR** A1.2 level proficiency (speaking).

- 1. Students will be able to use vocabulary (approx. 300 basic nouns, verbs, adjectives, and expressions).
- 2. Students will be able to function in everyday situations, such as expressing opinions, talking about experiences, giving advice, etc. in Japanese.
