Japanese Small Talk Skills for Better Social Relationships

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[Course Description]

Mhether you lack confidence in participating in such conversations, are already actively engaging in them, or believe you have sufficient proficiency in Japanese to do so, this course is designed for you. In casual situations where there is no specific purpose (e.g., asking a stranger for directions or making a request to a friend), these conversations are referred to as zatsudan (雜談) in Japanese. In English, they are commonly known as 'small talk' or 'chatting.' Zatsudan is not just a waste of words; it plays a crucial role in building positive social relationships with friends and people around you. Throughout this course, you will study approximately 300 commonly used words (expressions, phrases, and idioms) in Japanese zatsudan, along with techniques to sustain engaging conversations. These skills will help you cultivate meaningful social connections and interactions.

Attention: This course places a strong emphasis on speaking practice, making it an ideal choice for students seeking active participation in class.

By the end of the course, you should be able to:

- Comprehend approximately 300 commonly used words in casual conversations.
- Use these approximately 300 commonly used words effectively in your daily interactions.
- Grasp zatsudan techniques to sustain engaging conversations in casual settings.
- Apply these techniques with confidence to maintain engaging conversations in casual settings.

Small Talk Tasks: In the latter part of each class, students will apply the vocabulary and techniques they have learned on that day, as well as in previous classes, to craft brief conversational skits in pairs. These skits will then be presented during class.

Video Project: You will have the opportunity to showcase your knowledge through a video project, applying what you've learned during the semester (Words 1-19 & Techniques 1-19). Further details about the project will be provided in class.

Final Exam: A comprehensive final exam covering the entire course content will be scheduled for the last week of the semester. Specific details about the final exam will be shared in class.

Class Performance: Active and informed participation in class is essential to create a productive learning environment. Please refrain from activities that may hinder your engagement, such as using smartphones, chatting in English with classmates during class, or frequently leaving the classroom. Failure to actively participate may result in a deduction from your final grade.
